

## Parking Information for Attendees

**The IECA Northeast Chapter's COASTAL CONFERENCE will be held at the University of Rhode Island Kingston Campus at the Coastal Institute**

**Driving directions to the University of Rhode Island (URI) Kingston Campus and specific directions to the Coastal Institute are posted on the URI website at <http://www.uri.edu/ce/wq/nemo/Workshops-Support/index.htm>.** When you arrive on campus, please park your vehicle in the south end of the Fine Arts Parking Lot (Visitors Parking), as detailed on the enclosed map.

Please cut off the temporary parking pass below, fill in your vehicle license plate number, and place it on the driver's side dashboard so that it is clearly visible. **Failure to do so can result in a parking ticket or the towing of your vehicle. This pass is valid only for the Fine Arts Parking Lot (Visitors Parking); parking in any other area is prohibited.**

The Coastal Institute, where the workshop is being held, is about a 5-minute walk from the Fine Arts Parking Lot. Its location has been marked on the enclosed map. The main door of the Coastal Institute is located at the northern end of the building, facing Flagg Road. The workshop will be held in the Weaver Auditorium, which is the first right when entering the main door. **Please arrive early enough to park your vehicle, walk to the Coastal Institute, and enjoy light refreshments before the workshop.**

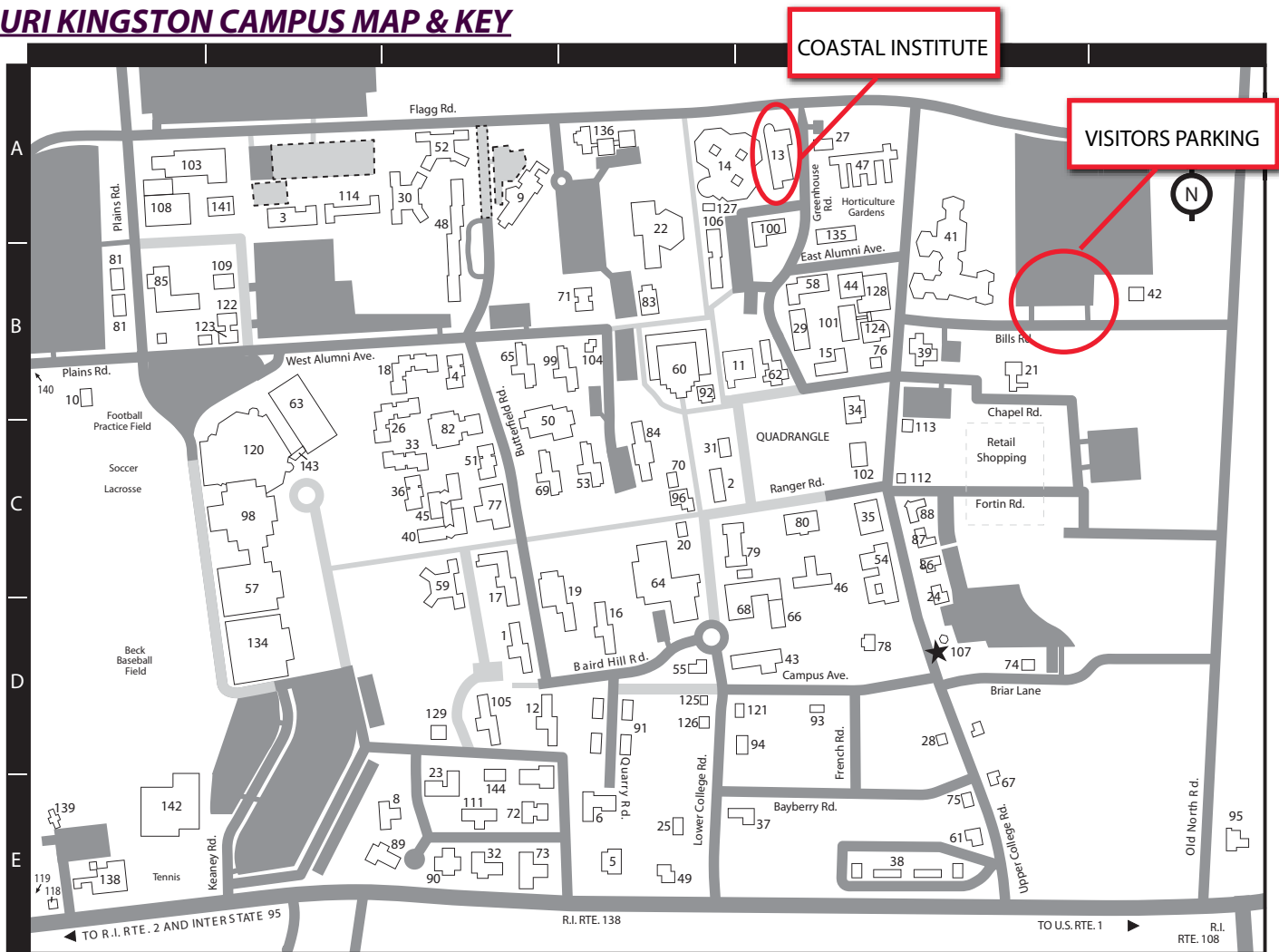
